

**Changes to BIIAB handbooks required by the commencement of the Public Health (Minimum Price for Alcohol) (Wales) Act 2018.**

On 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2020 all licensed premises in Wales must comply with the Public Health (Minimum Price for Alcohol) (Wales) Act 2018. This legislation sets out that a minimum price of 50p per a unit of alcohol must be charged. This addendum details the changes required to BIIAB handbooks following this change.
