

Changes to BIIAB handbooks required by the commencement of the Air Weapons and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2015

On 15 May 2017 a number of new conditions come into force amending the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005. This addendum details the changes required to BIIAB handbooks following this change.
