

Changes to Scottish qualifications due to Lower Drink Drive Limit

On 5 December 2014 the Scottish Government introduced a new law which came into force affecting changes to the drink-drive limit in Scotland. This addendum details the changes required to the Scottish Certificate for Personal Licence Holders at SCQF Level 6, the Scottish Certificate for Personal Licence Holders (Refresher) at SCQF Level 6 and the Scottish Certificate for Licensed Premises Staff handbook following this change.
